Psychic Dots

Effect: Audience follows along in a game with 5 dots. Mr. Magician eliminates dots till he can correctly predict where everyone has freely chosen. Dots can be drawn on a whiteboard or could be done with any 5 objects i.e.: candy, cards, coins etc...

<u>Method</u>: It's Mathematical and will land on the second spot every time. with the 5 dots in a row all you have to do is follow the formula. We'll use A-E for an example:

ABCDE

"Everyone in your mind start at A"

Explain that every time I say MOVE then move one space to the left or right. Notice

that being on spot A you can only move to spot B because there is nothing on the other side of it. This is important because you don't want anyone to jump from A to E.

"So, go ahead and do that in your mind, MOVE to B'

Explain now if we play you have choices and therefore, I can't possibly know how you move from here. From B you are gonna have them move 4 times. Mathematically you cannot land on E so you eliminate it

ABCD

"Move 1 more time", Mathematically eliminates D

A B C

From here you just have to ask them to move an odd amount of times. I always do 3 to keep it simple. They can only choose B or Not B at this point so as long as it's an odd number they will always be on B.

<u>B</u>

Side notes: Just to make sure I'm following the formula, I like to play along in my own mind and if I fall on B I'm pretty sure they will. I learned this from Ben Train and he calls it Candy from Strangers in which he uses skittles candies. I know it's older than that but I couldn't find any history on it. Have fun with it and **ENJOY!**
